

FIRE SAFETY INFORMATION FOR RESIDENTS



WHAT TO THINK ABOUT BEFORE A FIRE

- Call 112 for the fire brigade when you see a fire. They need to know what has happened and the address of the fire.
- There is no charge when calling 112. You can call this number without a SIM card.
- Make sure to know the evacuation assembly point for your housing.
- If you must evacuate the premises for a fire or accident, it is important to gather at the evacuation assembly point. If anyone is missing from the group, they may be left in the building, so the fire brigade can go in to look for them.
- Smoking is not permitted indoors. Smoking in bed can cause a fire.

WHAT TO DO IF A FIRE STARTS

- Save yourself, warn others, alert, extinguish.
- Warn others who are nearby.
- Alert the fire brigade – call 112.
- Try to extinguish the fire with a handheld fire extinguisher or a fire blanket. Take no unnecessary risks.
- Meet the fire engines to show them where the fire is.
